#### Who can Join?

Membership to the Alliance is free and open to anyone that fit into one of the categories below.

- **Knowledge user:** An individual in a position to use research findings to make informed decisions about health policies, programs and/or practices (e.g., policy maker, health care provider, patient group).
- **Patient:** An overarching term inclusive of individuals with personal experience of a health issue and includes informal caregivers, including family and friends (see additional 1-pager).
- **Researcher:** An individual with a full-time, independent research appointment at an academic or research institution (e.g., scientist, assistant professor).
- Trainee: A graduate student or post-doctoral fellow who works under the formal supervision of an independent researcher. NOTE: Must have a supervisor or mentor who is a current member of the Alliance, in order to register.
