# **2021 SPOR Evidence Seed Grant Opportunity**

#### At a Glance

The Strategy for Patient-Oriented Research (SPOR) Evidence Alliance is pleased to host its third annual seed grant funding opportunity on the theme of *Knowledge Dissemination and Implementation with Patient Partnership, Using an Equity, Diversity, Inclusion and Social Justice Lens*.

The grant supports methods projects at the idea stage to encourage a culture of learning, innovation, and advancement of science in the areas of knowledge synthesis, guideline development, knowledge translation, and patient-oriented research.

For this completion, only projects studying **methodological advancements of knowledge dissemination and implementation will be considered**. Successful projects must incorporate an equity, diversity, inclusion, and social justice lens, and must have a strong focus on patient-oriented research.

### **Applicant Eligibility**

- All doctoral and post-doctorallevel trainees and early career researchers (i.e., full-time, independent researcher for a period of 0 to 5 years)<sup>1</sup> at a Canadian institution are eligible to apply.
- Applicants must be registered members or become a member of the SPOR Evidence Alliance.
  Everyone is welcome to join and membership registration can be completed here.

Funding for two awards, valued at \$10,000 each, is available for the 2021 competition.

#### **Theme**

Knowledge Dissemination and Implementation with Patient Partnership, Using an Equity, Diversity, Inclusion and Social Justice Lens.

Knowledge dissemination is defined as an active process to communicate results to users<sup>2</sup>. Implementation science is "the scientific study of methods to promote the systematic uptake of research findings and other evidence-based practices into routine practice...to improve the quality and effectiveness of health services and care".
